O P I N I O N

This application jointly filed October 24, 1958, by Southern Pacific Company and McCloud River Railroad Company, asks that the Commission authorize and approve pursuant to Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code, the conveyance of two strips of land by quitclaim deed from Southern Pacific Company to McCloud River Railroad Company. In the application it is alleged that this land has no book value but its market value is \$185, the sale price, and that Southern Pacific Company no longer needs this property for railroad purposes but that the use of said property is required by the purchasing carrier for railroad purposes.

The Commission finds that the proposed transfer of real property will not be adverse to the public interest. Therefore, it will be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary. The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a determination of the value of the real estate to be conveyed.

O R D E R

Application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and being of the opinion that Application No. 40540 should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority requested by the above-named applicants is hereby granted, permitting Southern Pacific Company to convey the property described in Exhibit A and in a drawing attached to the application, to McCloud River Railroad Company upon payment by the latter of \$185.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time is extended, and that the effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
