ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 53222 dated June 12, 1956, in this proceeding, James Lewis Robinson was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh or green vegetables between Hemet, on the one hand, and Los Angeles and San Diego, on the other hand.

Applicant has not accepted the certificate nor filed tariffs as required by Decision No. 53222. It appears that the certificate of public convenience and necessity should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to James Lewis Robinson by Decision No. 53222 dated June 12, 1956, in Application No. 36082, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon James Lewis Robinson in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon James Lewis Robinson, unless before such effective date, he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth therein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
