FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and city carrier permits. By Decision No. 55979 of December 16, 1957, in this proceeding, it was authorized, as a city carrier, under Section 4015 of the Public Utilities Code, to perform in San Francisco the services of unloading and segregating pool car shipments of periodicals for The Cuneo Press without assessing the charges set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 220 series of City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A for marking, stenciling, tagging or labeling. The authority is scheduled to expire January 5, 1959. Permission is sought to continue to deviate from the minimum rates for a further one-year period.

The supplemental application states that the conditions which justified the original deviation from the minimum rates still obtain. The supplemental application shows that on or about November 3, 1958, a copy thereof was served on interested parties. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed exemption from the requirement of charging for marking or stenciling is reasonable and consistent with the public interest. The supplemental application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted San Francisco Warehouse Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 55979 of December 16, 1957, in this proceeding, is hereby extended to January 5, 1960, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
