SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-A sets forth minimum rates, rules and regulations for transportation performed within the San Diego Drayage Area. Item No. 10 thereof names certain holidays to be used in connection with various rates provided in the tariff. By this petition the California Trucking Associations, Inc. seeks the inclusion of Washington's Birthday and December 24 as holidays in that item.

The petition alleges that as a result of recent labor agreements, December 24 is now a day for which premium holiday wages must be paid. It also alleges that Washington's Birthday, though not included in the tariff, is included in the previous and current labor contracts as a holiday.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is justified. The petition will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-A (Appendix "B" of Decision No. 55256, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 31, 1959, First Revised Page 4, which revised page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

(2) That tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the effective date hereof on not less than three days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and that such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than January 31, 1959.

In all other respects said Decision No. 55256, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
