## ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 56404 dated March 25, 1958, in this proceeding, Crest Messenger & Delivery Service, Inc., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier of property between Bandini, Beverly Hills and Vernon. Applicant received an extension of time until October 21, 1958, to file its acceptance and until November 20, 1958, to file tariffs and establish the service.

Applicant has written the Commission declining to accept the certificate granted by Decision No. 56404. It appears, therefore, that the certificate should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Crest Messenger & Delivery Service, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 56404 dated March 25, 1958, in Application No. 36034, as amended, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Crest Messenger & Delivery Service, Inc., in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service upon Crest Messenger & Delivery Service, Inc., unless, before such effective date, it shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
