ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 53309 dated June 26, 1956, in this proceeding, Thomas E. Reyes was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh or green vegetables between the Coachella Valley Territory and Los Angeles.

Applicant accepted the certificate on October 24, 1956. However, he has not filed tariffs as required by Decision No. 53309. By letter dated July 22, 1958, the Secretary of the Commission wrote applicant regarding the filing of tariffs. No reply to this letter has been received. In the circumstances, it appears that the certificate should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Thomas E. Reyes by Decision No. 53309 dated June 26, 1956, in Application No. 36182, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Thomas E. Reyes in the manner prescribed by law.


