ORDER

The County of San Diego is authorized to widen and improve Beryl Street (Crossing No. 36D-9.5) at grade across San Diego & Arizona Fastern Railway Company's La Mesa Branch near Lemon Grove, San Diego County, as described and shown in the application.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a minimum width of 28 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
