## $\underline{O P I N I O N}$

In the above-entitled application Percy L. Musser states that he desires to continue business as a motor transportation broker for which he has received licenses from this Commission from December 9, 1952 to and including December 31, 1958. His license for the year 1958 was granted pursuant to the Commission's Decision No. 56211 in Application No. 39619.

Applicant asserts that he would continue his brokerage business at two offices in Eureka, California, one at 4041 Williams Street and the other at Third and Broadway.

After full consideration of all the evidence in this proceeding, we find no reason to withhold issuance of a new license sought by applicant for the year 1959. Applicant has on file with the Commission a bond required by the provisions of Section 4838 of the Public Utilities Code, which is continuous in form. No public hearing appears to be necessary and the application will be granted.

## <u>O R D E R</u>

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a license is hereby granted to Percy L. Musser to act as a motor transportation broker as defined in Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That said licensee shall keep his license certificate as a motor transportation broker posted at his authorized places of business so that it is readily available to public inspection at all times.
- (b) That said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at Third and Broadway, and 4041 Williams Street, Eureka, until otherwise authorized by the Commission and for motor carriers hereinafter named, or for whom he may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

(2) That the license of said applicant shall authorize him to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation for property over the public highways of this state, said transportation to be rendered only by the motor carriers set forth on the list attached to the application.

(3) That the Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission is hereby authorized and directed to issue and deliver to Percy L. Musser a license certificate of the authority herein granted, said license certificate to be in the form heretofore adopted by the Commission for such license certificate and subject to the conditions hereinabove set forth.
