O P I N I O N

Alfred F. Antoni, doing business as Antoni Truck Lines, requests authority to exclude wood chips and wood shavings from the commodities which he may transport as a highway common carrier.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that he formed a new truck service under the business name of Antoni Transportation Service; that the new company was formed for the purpose of transporting waste wood chips and wood shavings from lumber mills in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties to Ukiah for the Masonite Corporation; that said service is performed under a contractual arrangement and requires the use of special trailer units which are particularly designed and constructed for the transportation of bulk shipments of wood waste; that the granting of applicant's request would establish the individuality of each service and would terminate any possible conflict of operating authority.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service for the transportation of wood chips and wood shavings. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Alfred F. Antoni, doing business as Antoni Truck Lines, to operate as a highway common carrier is hereby amended to exclude therefrom the transportation of wood chips and wood shavings, subject to the following conditions:

(a) That within sixty days after the date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend his tariffs currently in effect and on file with the Commission to exclude therefrom any provisions for the transportation of wood chips and wood shavings;

(b) That the amendment to the certificate shall become effective upon the effective date of the tariff amendments authorized in paragraph (a).

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
