ANTONI, doing business as ANTONI TRUCK LINES, for an order amending his certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate Application No. 40576 as a highway common carrier. <u>OPINION</u> Alfred F. Antoni, doing business as Antoni Truck Lines, requests authority to exclude wood chips and wood shavings from the commodities which he may transport as a highway common carrier. As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that he formed a new truck service under the business name of Antoni Transportation Service; that the new company was formed for the purpose of transporting waste wood chips and wood shavings from lumber mills in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties to Ukiah for the Masonite Corporation; that said service is performed under a contractual arrangement and requires the use of special trailer units which are particularly designed and constructed for the transportation of bulk shipments of wood waste; that the granting of applicant's request would establish the individuality of each scrvice and would terminate any possible conflict of operating authority. After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service for the transportation of wood chips and wood shavings. A public hearing is not necessary. - 1 -
