Decision No. 57769 of December 30, 1958, in these proceedings, authorized Consolidated Freightways, Inc., to continue to deviate from the minimum rates in connection with certain transportation.




Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 57769 of December 30, 1958, in these proceedings, shall be January 15, 1959.
