ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

KAY WRIGHT, 4071 Santa Ana Street, Huntington Park, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that prior to December 19, 1958, complainant was a subscriber and user of telephone service furnished by defendant under number LUdlow 8-2840 at 4071 Santa Ana Street, Apartment D, Huntington Park, California; that on or about December 19, 1958, the telephone facilities of complainant were removed and disconnected by the defendant pursuant to instructions from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office, which office caused Mary Carpinelli to be arrested on or about said date on a charge of suspicion of bookmaking; that complainant had no knowledge that the said Mary Carpinelli was receiving wagers over said telephone number and that complainant was not present at the time she was arrested; that complainant did not use and does not now intend to use said telephone facilities as an instrumentality to violate the law nor in aiding or abetting such violation; and that complainant has suffered and will continue to suffer irreparable injury to her reputation and will suffer great hardship as a result

of being deprived of telephone service at said address.

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending hearing on said complaint and further Commission order thereon, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply to said complaint within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
