ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On November 25, 1957, the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., filed this petition seeking revisions in the zone rates published in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 for the transportation of rock and related commodities by dump truck equipment within Southern California territory.
