ORDER AMENDING DECISION


IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 57855, dated January 13, 1959, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended as follows:


1. Page 3: In line 7 change "cancellation" to read "cancellations".

4. Page 15: In lines 16, 19 and 30 change "41" to read "44".


5. Page 15: In line 18 change "charges" to read "changes".
