ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 51716, dated July 18, 1955, in this proceeding, Leonard C. McCurdy was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh or green vegetables between Shafter, Wasco and Bakersfield, and points within a 15-mile radius of Bakersfield, on the one hand, and Los Angeles, on the other hand.

Applicant has not accepted the certificate nor filed tariffs as required by Decision No. 51716, supra. It appears that the certificate should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Leonard C. McCurdy by Decision No. 51716, dated July 18, 1955, in Application No. 36267, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Loonard C. McCurdy in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the lawful service thereof upon Leonard C. McCurdy unless, before such effective date, he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
