ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 51710 dated July 18, 1955, in this proceeding, William O. Ward was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of hay and cottonseed between McFarland and points within a radius of 15 miles thereof, on the one hand, and Kingsburg and Los Angeles, on the other hand.

Applicant has not accepted the certificate nor filed tariffs as required by Decision No. 51710, supra. It appears that the certificate should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to William O. Ward by Decision No. 51710 dated July 18, 1955, in Application No. 36261 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon William O. Ward in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the lawful service thereof upon William O. Ward, unless before such effective date, he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
