ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 54016 dated October 30, 1956, in this proceeding, Oscar Gloistein was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of specified commodities between San Francisco, on the one hand, and points on U.S. Highways Nos. 101 and 101-by-pass from San Francisco to and including San Jose, on the other hand.

Applicant has not accepted the certificate nor filed tariffs as required by Decision No. 54016, supra. It appears that the certificate should be revoked.


Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Oscar Gloistein by Decision No. 54016 dated October 30, 1956, in Application No. 36064, is hereby revoked.


The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Oscar Gloistein in the manner prescribed by law.


