In the Matter of the Application of the City of Fullerton for an Order authorizing the Construction of a Grade Crossing of the UNION PACIFIC RAILWAY by the Westerly Prolongation of Valencia Mesa Drive in the City of Fullerton.

## O R D E R

The City of Fullerton is authorized to construct Valencia Mesa Drive at grade across Union Pacific Railroad Company's Anaheim Branch in the City of Fullerton, in Orange County, at the location described in the application as amended November 17, 1958, to be identified as Crossing No. 3Y-14.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 28 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), which shall be installed adjacent to the paved roadway.

Upon completion, the private crossing at Mile Post 14.7, about 2,000 feet southerly, shall be abandoned and closed.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
