O P I N I O N

Harry I. Bobb and C. R. Christensen were copartners engaged in the warehouse and grain cleaning business in the County of Yolo under the name of Union Storage Company. On January 2, 1955, Harry I. Bobb died testate and his widow, Gladys S. Bobb, was appointed executrix of his estate. Pursuant to a final order of distribution decedent's widow and son, Aaron F. Bobb, succeeded to his interest in said partnership.

Applicants therefore request authority to transfer the public utility assets of the partnership formerly conducted by Harry I. Bobb and C. R. Christensen to the partnership of C. R. Christensen, Aaron F. Bobb and Gladys S. Bobb.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That C. R. Christensen and Gladys S. Bobb, as executrix of the estate of Harry I. Bobb, may transfer to C. R. Christensen, Gladys S. Bobb and Aaron F. Bobb, the warehouse property and assets of the partnership formerly conducted by Harry I. Bobb and C. R. Christensen under the name of Union Storage Company.

2. That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, effective concurrently with the consummation of such transfer, applicants shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission in the names of Harry I. Bobb and C. R. Christensen to show that said rates, rules and regulations have been withdrawn or canceled and that C. R. Christensen, Gladys S. Bobb and Aaron F. Bobb have adopted or established as their own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
