San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to relocate its existing branch line track and spur track and to construct a drill track extension and a spur track along and across Marshall Avenue, in the City of El Cajon, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application and as shown on the map attached thereto.

Marshall Avenue is not improved at the location of the proposed relocation and construction, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across or along said tracks.

Applicant is further authorized to relocate its branch line track across Main Street (Crossing No. 36D-16.9). Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 with tops of rails flush with existing roadway. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Applicant shall beer entire construction and maintenance expense.

Clearances shall be in conformance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D, except that applicant is authorized to deviate from the requirements of subsection 3.17 thereof to the extent depicted on San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company drawing E-1437 as revised June 18, 1957, provided that no poles are located between said track and the west property line of Marshall Avenue, El Cajon, San Diego County.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
