QRDER

Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across six streets near Del Paso, Sacramento County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified and provided with protection as set forth in the following table:

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days from the date hereof.
