SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 37910 dated May 22, 1945, Joseph R. Vierra was authorized by this Commission to render service as a passenger stage corporation between Marysville and Camptonville and intermediate points via Browns Valley and Dobbins, except that no local service would be provided between Marysville and Browns Valley Junction, or points intermediate thereto.

Joseph R. Vierra, on August 9, 1958, notified this Commission that he was transferring his Highway Contract Carrier Permit to O. F. Gingrich. Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 58-177 was transferred to O. F. Gingrich on September 15, 1958. The Commission was later notified by Mr. Gingrich on September 29, 1958 that he did not desire the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation.

On September 15, 1958, Joseph R. Vierra discontinued service and subsequently permitted his public liability and property damage insurance policy, as required by General Order No. 101, to lapse. On December 30, 1958, the Commission rendered Decision No. 57767, in Application No. 26441. This order revoked the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate passenger stage service between Marysville and Camptonville, California. Supplemental Order is being issued because the Commission has learned that Mr. Joseph R. Vierra passed away on November 8, 1958 prior to Decision No. 57767. This supplemental decision will therefore be served upon the estate of Joseph R. Vierra.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by Decision No. 37910, dated May 22, 1945, in Application No. 26441, and all operating rights owned and possessed by Joseph R. Vierra authorizing passenger stage service between Marysville and Camptonville, California, are hereby revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs on file are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon the estate of Joseph R. Vierra in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
