ORDER RESCINDING REVOCATION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 57776, issued December 30, 1958, in this proceeding, provided that the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Thomas E. Reyes would be revoked because applicant had not filed the required tariffs.


The effective date of the decision was to be the twentieth day after service unless, before such effective date, the carrier shall have filed with this Commission a written response to the order denying the facts set forth therein. On January 19, 1959, Thomas E. Reyes filed a response, thereby staying the effective date of said Decision No. 57776. The response stated that Reyes had contacted his tariff agent and that the required tariff filings would be made on or before January 25, 1959. Such tariff filings were made and filed with this Commission on January 21, 1959, and became effective January 31, 1959. In the circumstances, the order of revocation in Decision No. 57776, supra, will be rescinded.


Therefore, good cause appearing,
