ORDER RESCINDING REVOCATION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 57981, issued February 9, 1959, in this proceeding provided for the revocation of a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to George F. Lloyd Transportation Co. upon the basis of information that the company had not filed the required tariffs and does not perform any operations under the certificate.

The effective date of the decision was to be the twentieth day after service unless before such effective date the company shall have filed with this Commission a written response denying the facts set forth therein. On February 17, 1959, applicant filed a response alleging that its tariff was on file and that it has held out its services and conducted the required operation pursuant to its certificate.

Further investigation has developed that the required tariffs were in fact filed and became effective on November 29, 1957. Accordingly, Decision 57981 will be rescinded.
