SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 contains minimum rates, rules and regulations governing the transportation of rock, sand, pravel, asphaltic concrete, cold oil road mixtures, and certain other commodities in dump truck equipment between points in California. Section No. 3 thereof provides, among other rates, minimum zone rates, in cents per ton, for transportation from certain defined production areas to delivery zones in southerm California. By Decision No. 55889 of December 3, 1957, in Case No. 5437, the Commission directed its staff to conduct a study of the production area zone descriptions and zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7.

The transportation rate staff has submitted the study as directed, in the form of a proposed exhibit submitted by an Associate Transportation Rate Expert. The exhibit shows that the recommendations therein contained were based upon a review of all the southern California dump truck production areas currently

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defined in the tariff. The staff members contacted responsible parties familiar with the facts and circumstances surrounding the operations of plants in the respective production areas. Among the persons consulted were producers, property owners, carrier and producer association representatives, and city and county public officials and employees. Visual observations were made of the production facilities and physical locations of these facilities in relationship to presently described production areas were noted.

The staff exhibit recommends specific revisions in 48 of the 71 production areas in southern California. The changes are designed to effect practical improvements in the boundary descriptions. The changes are stated to be necessary or desirable in the interest of tariff simplification and clarification, and to correct descriptions which are obsolete or otherwise unsatisfactory. The exhibit points out various respects in which zone changes have been made necessary by reason of new street dedications, openings, extensions, relocations and name changes, changes in city boundaries, changes in land usage, and various other factors. No rate changes would result from any existing production point as the result of the staff proposals.

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Based upon staff recommendations in an earlier phase of the staff study, production area descriptions and rates applicable from 11 out-of-date production areas were canceled by Decision No. 57975, in Case No. 5437, dated February 3, 1959.

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The proposed staff exhibit in draft form was distributed to known interested parties on or about December 23, 1958, for their advance review and comment. All who replied concurred in the staff recommendations with minor exceptions, which have been adjusted in the final exhibit. Carrier and shipper associations have endorsed the staff recommendations and commended the staff for making them.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission so finds, that the tariff modifications recommended in the staff exhibit are appropriate, reasonable and justified. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 will be revised accordingly. The staff exhibit is hereby made a part of the record in this proceeding, identified as Exhibit F-1. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary.

> Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 32566, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 1, 1959, the revised pages attached hereto, and listed in Appendix "A" also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof by this reference.

(2) In all other respects, said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
