Decision No. 52478

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the investigation into the rates, rules and regulations, charges, allowances and practices of all common carriers, highway carriers and city carriers relating to the transportation of any and all commodities between and within all points and places in the State of California (including, but not limited to, transportation for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2).

ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

By Order Setting Hearing, dated June 26, 1956, in Case No. 5432, the Commission ordered that hearings be held for the purpose of determining whether Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended to include a reduced rate proposed by Winans Bros. Trucking Co., a highway common carrier, for the transportation of lumber and forest products from Hayfork to Redding. Decision No. 54210 of December 4, 1956, in this proceeding, ordered that the proceeding be continued and its disposition deferred pending disposition of other phases of this case.

In Decision No. 58086 of March 2, 1959, in Case No. 5436 (Petition No. 12 and Order Setting Hearing, dated October 30, 1956) involving a similar rate question, the Commission found after hearing that publication of such rates in the minimum rate tariffs would not be in the public interest. Accordingly, the Order Setting Hearing, dated June 26, 1956, in Case No. 5432, will be discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Order Setting Hearing, dated June 26, 1956, in Case No. 5432, is hereby discontinued.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
