ORDER

The County of San Diego is authorized to relocate the crossing of Cypress Avenue at grade with San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company's La Mesa Branch, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-9.61, in Lemon Grove, San Diego County, as described in the application as amended February 13, 1959, and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 52 feet, with grades of approach substantially as shown on the amended Exhibit "D". Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-3), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 36D-9.6 about 50 feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
