OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and petroleum contract carrier permits.¹ By Decision No. 56812 of June 9, 1958, in Application No. 40052, he was authorized, under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, to deviate from the requirements of Item No. 70-D of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by assessing charges for the transportation of bakery goods in wheeled carriers on the net weight of the bakery goods exclusive of the weight of said wheeled carriers. The current authorization is scheduled to expire April 22, 1959. By this application, authority is sought to continue to deviate from the minimum rates for a further one-year period.

According to the application, the conditions which justified deviation from the minimum rates still exist. It asserts that applicant has operated successfully during the past year and can continue to operate successfully and profitably during the ensuing year with the sought deviation.

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Applicant's radial highway common carrier permit is conditioned to exclude the transportation involved in this proceeding. (Decision No. 56812 of June 9, 1958, in Application No. 40052).

A copy of the application was served on California Trucking Associations, Inc. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rate deviation is reasonable. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED:


(1) That Young's Commercial Transfer, Inc., is hereby authorized to assess charges for the transportation of shipments of bakery goods in wheeled carriers on the net weight of the bakery goods exclusive of the weight of said wheeled carriers.


(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire April 22, 1960, unless sooner changed, canceled or extended by order of the Commission.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.


