SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Joe J. Rossi & Co., Inc., a corporation, operates as a petroleum irregular route carrier. On September 1, 1958, it amended its articles of incorporation to change its corporate name to Rossi Transportation, Inc. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Decision No. 49527, dated January 5, 1954, in Application No. 34913, is hereby amended by substituting "Rossi Transportation, Inc.," in place of "Joe J. Rossi & Co., Inc."

(2) That within ninety days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that Joe J. Rossi & Co., Inc., has withdrawn

or canceled and Rossi Transportation, Inc., has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
