ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Irving D. Osburn, Russell K. Powell and Gail Turley, partners, (B and O Service Company) possess a petroleum irregular route carrier certificate authorizing operation between points and places in the Counties of Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo and Monterey.

The liability insurance policy of Irving D. Osburn, Russell K. Powell and Gail Turley, partners, lapsed as of April 1, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Irving D. Osburn, Russell K. Powell and Gail Turley, partners, by Decision No. 56065 dated January 14, 1958, in Application No. 39554 is suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Irving D. Osburn, Russell K. Powell and Gail Turley, partners, are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with

said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Irving D. Osburn, Russell K. Powell and Gail Turley, partners.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
