Application of SAN DIEGO TRANSIT SYSTEM,  
 a corporation, for authority to abandon  
 its "Fiesta del Pacifico" Excursion Service.

O P I N I O N

Applicant seeks authority to discontinue its Fiesta del Pacifico Excursion Service heretofore authorized in Decisions Nos. 53349 and 55252. This is a special one-event service which operates only during the dates of the fiesta.

The service was operated on a daily basis during the fiesta period of 1956, which resulted in a total loss of \$434.95. During the 1957 fiesta it was operated on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays only, which resulted in a total loss of \$332.25. Operation in both years was on a share-the-loss basis with the Kiwanis Club of Old San Diego under the arrangement as set forth in paragraph 7 of the letter attached to Application No. 39146 as Exhibit "D". As a result of the poor financial showing in 1956 and 1957, the Kiwanis Club of Old San Diego requested that the service be not operated at all during the 1958 fiesta. As the future plans for Fiesta del Pacifico have taken a somewhat different form from the previous years, it appears unlikely that there will be any future request for this service, and applicant therefore proposes to abandon it.

Copies of this application were mailed to local authorities and other interested parties. The application is not opposed. It appearing that public convenience and necessity no longer require the operation of said transportation service, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Transit System, a corporation, may discontinue its Fiesta del Pacifico Excursion Service, and Appendix A to Decision No. 55090 is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Fourth Revised Page 2 of Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof. Original Page 33A of Appendix A to Decision No. 55090, issued by Decision No. 56322, is hereby canceled.

Applicant shall, within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, amend its tariff and time schedule to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
