ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Harry Wendell, doing business as Harry Wendell's Freight Line, possesses a highway common carrier certificate authorizing operations for the transportation of general commodities between Calistoga, on the one hand, and certain points in Lake County, on the other hand.

The liability insurance policy of Harry Wendell lapsed as of April 27, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Harry Wendell by Decision No. 49649, dated February 9, 1954, in Application No. 35000, is suspended pending further order.

A. 35000-AC

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Harry Wendell are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Harry Wendell and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Classification Committee, Agent, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, and E. J. McSweeney, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Harry Wendell shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
