O P I N I O N

Applicant operates a passenger stage service in the San Gabriel-Alhambra-Monterey Park areas.<sup>1</sup> By this application authority is sought to (1) make a minor route change along its "No. 3, Mooney-6th Street" route by operating along Park Street instead of Corto Street, (2) join its "No. 2, Marengo-Del Mar" and "No. 1, Granada-Mission" routes, for Saturday service only, by operating along Garvey Avenue, and (3) suspend its "No. 4, L. A. State College" route until the opening of school in September 1959.

A Commission staff transportation engineer has made a favorable report.

The suspension of the No. 4 route service appears justified on the basis of applicant's past experience showing that an average of less than three passengers per round trip were carried. The college has just recently been opened and it is expected that with the enrollment of the new freshman class a second attempt to

establish a compensatory service may be justified. Service to the college is also provided by applicant's No. 1 line.

The proposed reroutings of routes Nos. 1, 2 and 3 will not materially inconvenience present patrons and they appear to be in the public interest.

The Commission having considered the matter is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

For the purpose of clarification, applicant will be granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity in lieu of its present operating authority.

#### O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and having found as hereinabove set forth,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it hereby is granted to Foster Transportation, Incorporated, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of persons between the points and along the routes as set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the conditions and restrictions, if any, as set forth in said Appendix A.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, Foster Transportation, Incorporated, shall comply with the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

(3) That applicant may temporarily discontinue its present Route "No. 4, L. A. State College" service until the opening of the 1959 fall term.

(4) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in paragraph (1) of this order is in lieu of and supersedes all existing certificates of public convenience and necessity or other passenger stage operating authority heretofore granted to or

acquired by Foster Transportation, Incorporated, which certificates and rights are hereby revoked and canceled concurrently with the effective date of the tariff filings required by paragraph (2)b hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

Section 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,  
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

The certificate hereinafter noted supersedes all operative authority heretofore granted to Foster Transportation, Incorporated.

Foster Transportation, Incorporated, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers between points in the cities of Alhambra, San Gabriel, Monterey Park, Los Angeles, and adjacent areas, and intermediate points along the routes as hereinafter described, subject to the following provisions:

- a. Motor vehicles may be turned at termini or intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- b. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.

Section 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS

Route 1 - Granada-Mission

Beginning at the intersection of Fremont Avenue and Valley Boulevard, thence loop via Valley Boulevard, Westmont Drive, Hellman Avenue, Elm Street, Ross Avenue, and Fremont Avenue to Valley Boulevard; thence via Fremont Avenue, Mission Road, Concord Avenue, Winchester Avenue, Commonwealth Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Main Street, Hidalgo Avenue, Mission Road, Santa Anita Street, Las Tunas Drive, and San Gabriel Boulevard to Garvey Avenue.

Route 2 - Marengo-Del Mar

Beginning at the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard and Hellman Avenue, thence loop via Atlantic Boulevard, Emerson Avenue, Hathaway Avenue, Midwickhill Drive, Campbell Avenue, and Hellman Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard; thence via Atlantic Boulevard, Valley Boulevard, Marengo Avenue, Main Street, Chapel Avenue, Alhambra Road, Roses Road, Del Mar Avenue to Garvey Avenue.

Alternate Route

Garvey Avenue between Del Mar Avenue and San Gabriel Boulevard on Saturdays only.

Beginning at the intersection of Sixth Street and Hellman Avenue, thence via Sixth Street, Main Street, Chapel Avenue, Park Street, Almanson Avenue, Adams Avenue, Ramona Street, New Avenue to Garvey Avenue; thence loop via New Avenue, Newmark Avenue, Pomelo Avenue, Mooney Drive, Del Mar Avenue, and Garvey Avenue to New Avenue.

Route 4 - Los Angeles State College

Beginning at the intersection of Garfield Avenue and Main Street in the City of Alhambra, thence via Main Street, Atlantic Boulevard, Mission Road, Fremont Avenue, Valley Boulevard, Mariondale Avenue, Barridge Road, and Landsdowne Avenue to the Ramona Campus of the Los Angeles State College.

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
