ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across 12th Street in the City of Chino, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BAB-520.42-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served by the proposed spur track has indicated an urgent need of early service and the applicant has requested waiver of the usual twenty-day waiting period; hence the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
