SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The respondent, Savage Transportation Company, Inc., having filed a request for a 90-day extension of time to comply with paragraph 5 of the order contained in Decision No. 57969 and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraphs 5 and 7 of the order contained in Decision No. 57969 are amended to read:

- "5. That on or before September 8, 1959, Savage Transportation Company, Inc., shall file with the Commission a report setting forth all undercharges found pursuant to the examination hereinabove required by paragraph 4."
- "7. That in the event charges to be collected as provided in paragraph 6 of this order, or any part thereof, remain uncollected on October 8, 1959, Savage Transportation Company, Inc., shall submit to the Commission, on the first Monday of each month, a report of the undercharges remaining to be collected and specifying the action taken to collect such charges and the result of such action until such charges have been collected in full or until further order of this Commission."

In all other respects Decision No. 57969 shall remain in full force and effect.
