AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION

Comes now the LAYTONVILLE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT:

Petitioner herein petitions the above-entitled Commission for
leave to amend its Petition on file in the above-entitled matter,
and for grounds therefor alleges the following:

I

Petitioner has heretofore filed with the above Commission its
Petition asking that the Public Utilities Commission fix the just
compensation to be paid by said District for the land, property
and rights of any character whatsoever of the LAYTONVILLE WATER
COMPANY, a corporation, used in connection with the water system
operated by said Water Company and serving the community of
Laytonville, Mendocino County, California.

II

That paragraph III of said Petition reads as follows:

That the LAYTONVILLE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT intends to acquire
under eminent domain proceedings, or otherwise, the lands,
property, and rights of any character whatsoever of said
LAYTONVILLE WATER COMPANY used in connection with the

1 water system operated by said Water Company and serving the
2 community of Laytonville, Mendocino County, California."

3 III

4 That this Commission, by its Order dated March 10, 1959, deter-
5 mined that it had jurisdiction to proceed to hear the Petition and
6 fix the just compensation paid for the lands, property and rights
7 described in the Petition, and also in said Order said Commission
8 directed Petitioner to file a Petition for leave to amend its
9 present Petition and to set forth in detail the items of respond-
10 ent's property that Petitioner intends to acquire.

11 IV

12 That said paragraph III of said Petition should be amended to
13 read as follows:

14 That the LAYTONVILLE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT intends to acquire
15 under eminent domain proceedings, or otherwise, the lands, property
16 and rights of said LAYTONVILLE WATER COMPANY used in connection
17 with the water system operated by said Water Company and serving
18 the community of Laytonville, Mendocino County, California, all of
19 which are more particularly described as follows:

20 1 well, 527 feet deep, now in operation with the system.

21 1 deep well used turbine pump.

22 1 W & T Chlorinator.

23 1 12,000 gal. steel pressure tank.

24 All pipe, both steel and transite, now in service in the
25 water system, and all service connections as far as the
26 meter, and including the meter.

27 All hydrants and risers belonging to the Company.

28 All lands, rights of way, easements, or other interest in
29 land which is used in connection with the operation of the
30 Laytonville Water Company system.

31 All spare parts and fittings held in stock for maintenance of
32 the system.

All tools and equipment used in maintaining the system or
used specifically for the installation of new pipe or new
service connections.

All records and bookkeeping equipment used to record the
financial affairs of the Company, including, but not
limited to, meter books, service records, billing records
and invoices.

All rolling equipment owned by the Company and used exclusiv-
ly for the maintenance or operation of the water system.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the Petition to fix the just

1 compensation which shall be paid by the Petitioner for the acqui-
2 tion under eminent domain proceedings, or otherwise, of the lands,
3 property, and rights of the water system operated by the LAYTON-
4 VILLE WATER CO., heretofore filed in the above-entitled matter,
5 shall be amended as set forth herein.
