OPINION AND ORDER

Lester J. Geijsbeek and John H. Geijsbeek, copartners doing business as Geijsbeek Truckers, have filed this application for authorization to execute mortgages of chattels and to issue a note in the face amount of \$77,761.20.

Applicants are engaged in the transportation of property for hire and specialize in the transportation of lumber and forest products in California. They report that they are indebted to Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association at its Corning Branch in the sum of \$69,184.27, which sum is secured by two mortgages of chattels and is payable in monthly installments of \$4,779.50, and that they desire to refinance the indebtedness and to reduce the monthly payments.

Accordingly, applicants have made arrangements to take up the present note and to issue a new note to Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association at its Redding Branch for an amount of \$77,761.20, which includes the present indebtedness of \$69,184.27 and interest of \$8,576.93 on the new loan.
