## OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, J. A. Nevis Trucking, Inc. seeks authority to establish, in its Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 3, on less than statutory notice, a rule covering the exclusive use of the carrier's equipment for designated shipments. The proposed rule would apply only when the shipper places on the shipping document the words: "Exclusive use of equipment requested."

The application recites that applicant's tariff presently does not have any provision which would permit applicant to provide a shipper with exclusive use of equipment for less than truckload shipments; that shippers of applicant have requested this service in connection with less than truckload shipments which they desire to expedite; and that the proposed tariff item will permit applicant to meet this need by providing such shippers with equipment for special handling of this traffic. The proposed service would be available to all shippers who desire to use it. The volume of the rate attaching to the proposed service is at the level set by the Commission as minimum for use of the equipment when moving a full truckload.

In view of all of the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds that the publication of the proposed rule, including any increased charges resulting therefrom, is justified. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That J. A. Nevis Trucking, Inc., is hereby authorized to amend its Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 3, by publishing exclusive use of equipment provisions as set forth in Exhibit "A" of the above-entitled application.

(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
