ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Melba A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt, doing business as Merrimac Stage, possess a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of general commodities between Oroville and Elk's Retreat.

The liability insurance policy of Melba A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt lapsed as of May 12, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Melba A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt by Decision No. 54696, dated March 19, 1957, in Application No. 38772 is suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Melba A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt, doing business as Merrimac Stage, are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Melba A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date, Melbe A. Holt and Joyce L. Holt shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
