ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Northern Tank Lines, a corporation, possesses a petroleum irregular route carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of petroleum products in bulk, in tank trucks and tank trailers between all points and places in the State of California.

The liability insurance policy of Northern Tank Lines lapsed as of May 15, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier granted to Northern Tank Lines by Decision No. 51366, dated April 26, 1955, in Application No. 36775 is suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Northern Tank Lines are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Northern Tank Lines and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date, Northern Tank Lines shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
