6. Applicants shall not establish through routes or joint rates between San Francisco territory on the one hand and Los Angeles territory or Stockton on the other hand, nor between Los Angeles territory and Stockton.

Under authority granted by paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b), applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- 2. Automobiles, trucks and buses; viz., new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.

Note: This exception does not apply when the vehicle is crated, or tendered as part of a mixed shipment with other commodities, provided said crated vehicle or vehicle tendered as part of a mixed shipment is not transported in special truckaway equipment.

- 3. Livestock; viz., bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- 4. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
- 5. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- 6. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
- 7. Fruit, fresh, not cold pack or frozen.
- 8. Vegetables, fresh, not cold pack or frozen.
