## OPINION AND ORDER

Avalon Public Service Company, a corporation, has filed this application for authorization to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of \$125,000 for the purpose of refunding outstanding indebtedness.

Applicant owns and operates electric, gas and water utility plants on Santa Catalina Island. In financing its capital costs it issued, to Santa Catalina Island Company, two unsecured 4-1/2% notes in the aggregate amount of \$125,000, which notes ran for periods of less than twelve months and now are past due. It appears that the holder of the notes is willing to extend the time for payment and to accept a new note for \$125,000 which will be unsecured and will be payable on demand on or after March 1, 1960, with interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. A copy of the proposed note is attached to the application as Exhibit B.

In Exhibit A, applicant reports its net investment in utility plant at \$288,637 as of December 31, 1958, and its operating revenues for the year at \$351,932, with net income of \$26,670.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective when Avalon Public Service Company has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$125.
