## ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Richard F. McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., copartners (McCurdy & Son Transport Service), possess a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of specific commodities between points within the Los Angeles Drayage Area as described in Appendix A to Decision No. 56592, dated April 22, 1958, in this proceeding, and between said points, on the one hand, and certain cities in southern and northern California, on the other hand.

The liability insurance policy of Richard F. McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., lapsed as of June 8, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity
to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Richard F.
McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., co-partners, by Decision
Nc. 56592, dated April 22, 1958, in Application No. 36438, is
suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Richard F. McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., co-partners (McCurdy & Son Transport Service), are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Richard F. McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Classification Committee, Agent, and Consolidated Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date, Richard F. McCurdy and Richard F. McCurdy, Jr., shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
