ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Edwin J. Bieler and Bernerd Shapiro, copartners (doing business as JD Transportation Company), possess a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of general commodities between Los Angeles, Pasadena, South Pasadena, Lamanda Park and Oak Knoll.

The liability insurance policy of Edwin J. Bieler and Bernerd Shapiro lapsed as of June 6, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:


(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Edwin J. Bieler and Bernerd Shapiro by Decision No. 54884, dated April 22, 1957, in Application No. 38929, is suspended pending further order.


(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Edwin J. Bieler and Bernerd Shapiro are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Edwin J. Bieler and Bernard Shapiro and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Classification Committee, Agent, and Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date, Edwin J. Bieler and Bernard Shapiro shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
