ORDER

The City of Fullerton is authorized to construct Malvern Avenue at grade across Union Pacific Railroad Company's Anaheim Branch in The City of Fullerton, in Orange County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 3Y-14.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
