ORDER

The City of Pico Rivera is authorized to construct Passons Boulevard at grade across The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's Main Line in The City of Pico Rivera, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-151.45. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of the agreement attached to application as Exhibit "C". Width of crossing shall be not less than 65 feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B), without back lights.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 2-151.5 about 180 feet southeasterly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above

conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
