ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 55155, dated June 18, 1957, in this proceeding, Amador Distributing Co., a corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities between Jackson and Twin Lakes Resort.

Decision No. 55155, supra, ordered that in providing service pursuant to the certificate therein granted, Amador Distributing Co., shall, within the period therein specified, establish the service and file and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission. The required tariffs not having been filed, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted Amador Distributing Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 55155, dated June 18, 1957, in Application No. 38336, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Amador Distributing Co.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof upon Amador Distributing Co., unless before such effective date, it shall have filed with this
