In the Matter of the Application of
THE SISKIYOU TELEPHONE COMPANY

1. To Enter into a loan agreement with the United States of America under and pursuant to the Rural Electrification Act of 1936, as amended, acting through the Administrator of the Rural Electrification Administration;
2. To execute its promissory notes to said United States of America in the sum of \$797,000.00, said obligation to bear interest at the rate of two per cent per annum;
3. To execute and deliver a mortgage of realty and chattels covering all of the properties of applicant as security for the payment of said obligation;
4. To apply the proceeds derived from said notes to the expansion, rehabilitation and improvement of the plant and facilities of said company.

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 55457, dated August 27, 1957, the Commission authorized The Siskiyou Telephone Company to issue \$797,000 of notes to the United States of America, acting through the Rural Electrification Administration, for the purposes of financing the cost of expanding, rehabilitating and improving its facilities and service, and of paying outstanding indebtedness.

The Commission required the company to deposit the proceeds from the issue of the notes in a special bank account. At the outset, the Commission authorized the company to withdraw not to exceed

\$187,000 of such proceeds for specified purposes, and directed that the remaining proceeds should be used only for such purposes as the Commission might authorize in a supplemental order, or orders. The Commission required the company to file copies of such requisitions as it might make on the Rural Electrification Administration for the use of such remaining proceeds. By supplemental orders in the above-entitled proceeding, the Commission has approved the disbursement of \$318,180.42 of the remaining proceeds. Applicant now seeks approval of additional expenditures of \$11,230 on the contract for building unattended dial buildings at Etna, Hamburg, and Happy Camp and microwave buildings at Yreka, Gunsight Peak, and Slater Butte.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that an order should be entered approval the withdrawal of proceeds in the amount of \$11,230, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the requisition of The Siskiyou Telephone Company to draw down \$11,230 of proceeds from the issue of the notes authorized by Decision No. 55457, dated August 27, 1957, hereby is approved, and The Siskiyou Telephone Company hereby is authorized to disburse said sum of \$11,230 for the purposes indicated in said requisition.

This fourth supplemental order will become effective on the date hereof.




