FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission on June 29, 1959, by Decision No. 58668 in the above-entitled matter, authorized Wilbur O. White and Thelma B. White, doing business as Sacramento Valley Milling Company, to issue a note in the principal amount of not to exceed \$118,445 in substantially the same form as the note filed with their application which showed annual installments payable on the note of \$11,445.50; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the terms of repayment which were specified in said form of note and in the Commission's decision were in error; and,

WHEREAS, applicants, under date of July 1, 1959, have filed a corrected copy of the proposed note with the request that the Commission enter its order authorizing the issue of the same; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 58668, dated June 29, 1959, hereby is amended so as to permit Wilbur O. White and Thelma B. White to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of not to exceed \$118,445 payable in annual installments of \$11,844.50 which note shall be in, or substantially in, the same form as the note filed with the Commission under date of July 1, 1959, and to execute a deed of trust and a mortgage of chattels to secure the payment of said note.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 58668, dated June 29, 1959, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.

This First Supplemental Order is effective on the date hereof.
