ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co., a corporation, possesses a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of general commodities between points within the San Francisco-East Bay Cartage Zone as described in Appendix "A" to Decision No. 50867, dated December 14, 1954, in this proceeding.

The liability insurance policy of Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co. lapsed as of July 6, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:


(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co. by Decision No. 50867, dated December 14, 1954, in Application No. 35082 is suspended pending further order.


(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co. are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co. and a copy of this order to be mailed to William M. Larimore, Agent, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Western Classification Committee, Agent, and Leland C. Smith, Agent.


The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Alfred J. Olmo Drayage Co. shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.


